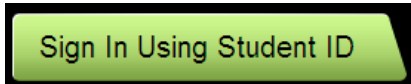


Kid's College Instructions/Explanation/Competition

Logging On:

1. Navigate to the district link for "Kids College" on the [LBMS student page](#).
2. Click on "Kids College" icon.



3. Select
4. Enter in student ID # on both prompts.
5. Choose a team. Choose a sport. Start answering questions.

Explanation:

1. Explain to the kids that while it's a game to them for the teacher's it's a teaching tool. We use it to...
 - a. **Measure progress** in a number of different ways.
 - b. **It identifies your strengths and weaknesses.** (Take one volunteer and while logged in as the teacher, show them the actual report.)
 - c. **It generates workbooks** which we could print out at any time and ask you to complete. (Show them the same kid's workbook.)
 - d. **Explain that it progresses through the grade level material as you correctly answer questions.** This is why they need to ask questions when they are stuck on a problem. After several attempts and wrong answers it drops you back and requires you to re-do things you may already know.
 - e. **The way to get more points is to level up academically,** not by scoring on games but by answering more difficult questions.
 - f. **Because it's a teaching/evaluation tool the students should always do their best.** Explain that this information could be used for placement at any time and to help them with their education they need to put their best effort forward so that in the future they get the services they need based on their actual strengths and

weaknesses. **For example: It's possible this data might be used to place them in enrichment/remediation classes, contests, tutoring, etc.**
