ELIGIBILITY STANDARDS

IMPORTANT:

1. Students must achieve the 1.50 G.P.A. during the last quarter of the previous school year in order to be eligible during the first quarter of the subsequent school year.
2. Students wishing to participate in defined extra-curricular events in the Fall Quarter must earn eligibility in the **4th quarter of the previous year** -for Burneson students this means successful passage of 75% of their course work, for WHS students this means a minimum of passing grades in **5** one credit courses (or the equivalent) during our last grading period and earn a minimum GPA of 1.50 for the quarter.
3. Remember- Summer School credit may not be used to substitute for failing grades from the preceding grading period of the regular school year.

BOARD OF EDUCATION POLICY IGDK-I

In order to be eligible to participate in interscholastic athletics and extracurricular activities, students shall meet the following criteria.

In order to be eligible in grades 9-12, a student must be currently enrolled and must have been enrolled in school the immediately preceding grading period (interscholastic only). During the preceding grading period, the student must have received passing grades in a minimum of five one-credit courses or the equivalent, which count toward graduation, and earn a grade point average of 1.50 or above. **Fall incoming 9th grade student's eligibility will be determined on the last grading period of the 8th grade.**

A student enrolling in the seventh grade for the first time will be eligible for the first-grading period regardless of previous academic achievement. Thereafter, in order to be eligible, a student in grade 7 or 8 must be currently enrolled and must have been enrolled in school the immediately preceding grading period and received passing grades during the period in 75% of those subjects carried the preceding grading period in which the student was enrolled, and earn a grade point average of 1.50 or above.

Students may participate in interscholastic athletics and extracurricular activities if they receive a failing grade for any course in the immediately preceding grading period provided they meet the eligibility requirements above. Students with Individual Education Plans will be expected to meet the eligibility standards set forth in this policy unless a specific modification is included in the student's Individual Education Plan.

Extracurricular activities are those activities not for academic credit that meet after school for two or more times per week on a regular basis or for a season. The principal of the high school and middle school shall publish a list of all activities and extracurricular activities subject to these standards at the beginning of the school year.
