



Dynamic Relations

In Dynamic Relations, students will learn how to build positive, healthy relationships now and in the future. They will develop skills necessary for interpersonal, family, school, community, and work settings. The students will participate in classroom activities to apply the skills they learn. The course addresses issues such as what makes relationships work and fail, family conflicts and crises, how to deal with stress, communication, dating, marriage, and family foundations.
