



FOCUS ON FASHION II

Focus on Fashion II further develops techniques covered in Focus on Fashion I. The course will also focus on projecting a positive image, budgeting for clothing, and the fashion industry. Each student will choose projects to complete ranging from home decorations to clothing items. Students are responsible for purchasing all materials they need to complete each project. If materials are not brought into class, credit will not be given for any project work and alternative assignments will be given to earn participation points ONLY.

TOPICS TO BE COVERED:

Techniques and/or study of the following:

- ✓ Hemming
- ✓ Fabrics and Fibers
- ✓ Color and Design
- ✓ Budgeting for Clothing
- ✓ Zippers
- ✓ Buttons and Buttonholes
- ✓ Careers in the Fashion Industry

SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- All project fabric (to be announced at projects are assigned)
