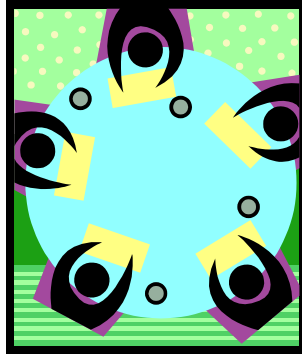


## Student Principal Advisory Council

The purpose for this committee is for the teaching staff to communicate and to facilitate action toward solving school issues. The meetings are held monthly and the process for these meetings is specifically stated and conducted.
