To complete this project you need to pick a World History content movie. You may use the web site listed above or a movie from the list provided (link on Mr. Jones web site). You may not go out on your own...you need to select a movie from one of these locations. **You may not choose Shindler's List or Hotel Rwanda**

You need to complete the following:

1. Movie Project Form (link on Mr. Jones web site)
2. 2-page summary Report (include a cover sheet)
3. Creative movie poster

Movie Project Form

Must be completed full and attached to your summary report. This should be the last page.
If the Movie you choose is rated "R" you must have a parental signature
You must sign the form and verify that you viewed the film

2 Page Summary Report. Include the following information and requirements in your report.

It must be typed, double spaced, 12 point, Times New Roman Font
A cover sheet is required that includes the Movie Title, Your Name, Date, and Class Period
The following question/answers should be integrated into your paper

- Why did you choose this movie?
- Did you enjoy watching it? Why/Why not?
- What is the main theme/plot of the movie?
- What seems to be historically accurate in the movie? What sources are you using to access accuracy?
- Is the movie primarily entertainment, or is it really trying to work within a historical period?
- What was the best scene in the movie? Why?
- Would you recommend this movie for the teacher to show to the class? Why/Why not?
- On a scale of 1 (worst)- 10 (best), rate the movie and explain your rating.

Movie Poster.- Include the following information and requirements in your poster.

1/2 poster-board size must approximate a movie poster that is used in movie theaters to advertise this film

It must be perfectly edited

Make it colorful (pretty it up!!!!)

All posters will be displayed, either in the classroom or the bulletin boards in the Social Studies hallway

Your completed form, report, and poster are due the first day back from Winter Break, during your class period. (January 4th, 2010)
